## MAIN ACTIVITIES

- **Skills Development:** 150 participants will receive pre-departure training on soft skills, languages (English and Italian), and technical knowledge related to the green transition. Curricula will be developed to facilitate skills certification and recognition.
- Mobility Phase: 100 young Egyptians (40 graduates and 60 agricultural technicians) will participate in 3-month traineeships in Apulia, Italy, with the possibility of obtaining a work visa. The goal is to address workforce demands in Italy and establish a sustainable circular mobility mechanism.
- Return Phase: Upon returning to Egypt, participants will be supported in integrating into the local labour market through capacity-building actions and technical and financial assistance for the creation of start-ups.

### **DESCRIPTION:**

NET-Work You aims at establishing a pioneering and **sustainable model** of circular and skilled labour mobility between Italy and Egypt. The project will offer a **traineeship** opportunity to **100 young Egyptians** in the Apulia Region, Southern Italy, focusing on skills enhancement in green economy, digitalization, and agriculture.

A **training programmme** will help participants to acquire valuable professional skills recognized in both countries, increasing their employment prospects in Europe and Egypt.

Additionally, the creation of a Mediterranean **multi-stakeholder network** will strengthen public-private partnerships at local, regional, and national levels in both countries, fostering the exchange of good practices with other EU Member States.
